Xylem Donation

Event Registration

About Aquaton

Aquaton, a Xylem Latin America initiative, addresses this critical need by engaging participants globally to donate kilometers through physical activities like walking, running, or biking. These efforts raise vital funds for water access projects in Latin America, the United States, Africa, and Europe. By supporting Aquaton, individuals contribute to sustainable solutions that combat water scarcity and improve livelihoods worldwide.

How do you start?

<u>Create an</u> account on the Aquaton website.

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Start accumulating kilometers by walking, biking or jogging. **Note:** Make sure to have a way to capture your distance. 3

Log into your account and register your kilometers by uploading a screenshot that proves those kilometers.


Aquaton Considerations

- Ensure you have a method to record your distance. (Example: Strava)
- Participate anywhere, with anyone and at anytime (open to the public).
- Consider planning a group walk to get steps in together.
- Only kilometers traveled during the month of November can be tracked.
- All kilometers contribute to the overall goal.
- Share your photos on external channels. Hashtags suggested #MonthofAction #MakeyourWatermark #XylemWatermark #Aquaton

Activity: Plogging

Plogging is the act of picking up trash while jogging, walking, riding your bike or anything that gets you outside and moving. In addition to preventing litter from polluting our waterways and oceans, plogging improves the health of individuals and the local community.

Plogging Considerations

Location Participants must comply with all local government and Xylem company safety precautions & guidelines.

Personal Protective Equipment

- Wear masks (optional), gloves (recommended nitrile gloves).
- Use a pair of barbecue or salad tongs or a litter picker if gloves don't seem like enough protection.
- Long pants and closed toe shoes.

Recommendations

- Only pick up litter that's easy to handle and dispose of, whether by placing in a dumpster or recycling cart. Do not pick up sharp objects.
- Wash your hands thoroughly after throwing out or recycling the trash.

Plan: Plogging

Step-by-step directions to plan your next event.

1	Recruit	Select 2-3 employees or volunteers to form a Plogging Planning Committee.
2	Choose Location	Select an open nearby space, safe for pedestrians, with a tendency to accumulate litter. Avoid traffic, busy crossings and major roads. If this is not feasible, make sure you have volunteers directing traffic or alerting ploggers. Examples: parks, walking trails, along a river, and around the company building.
3	Schedule	Confirm a date and time.
4	Outline Agenda	Develop a timeline for your event that includes set-up and clean-up.
5	Coordinate Materials	Plan for needed equipment like proper footwear, gloves, trash bags, water, snacks or lunch, litter picker or tongs, reflective vests (for visibility) and first-aid kit.
6	Trash Disposal	Research where you can dispose of all trash and separate in the correct recycling or trash bins. If needed, contact your local waste management service to coordinate trash pick-up.
7	Publicity Release Form	Ensure that all attendees in photos sign the form provided (page 16) before sharing photos on external channels. Hashtags suggested #MonthofAction #MakeyourWatermark #XylemWatermark
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Checklist: Plogging

Keep track of everything you need for your Watermark event.

Pre-Event

- Recruit 2-3 volunteers for the plogging planning committee.
 - Determine a date and time for the event.
- Map out the route. Ensure the route is clearly marked and any road crossings are safely managed.
- Connect with your Xylem contact if planning event together.
- Send all volunteers a reminder on the week of the event.
- Provide photo release forms for volunteers prior to the event.

Post-Event

Properly dispose trash and litter in the correct recycling or trash bins.

Record all volunteer hours via the participation form.

Materials and Safety Equipment





Activity: Water Filter Kit Build

Wine to Water is a nonprofit organization dedicated to providing clean water and sanitation to communities in need around the world. Through sustainable water projects and educational programs, Wine to Water aims to alleviate the global water crisis, empowering communities to thrive with access to safe drinking water.



Location: In-person



Volunteers: Maximum 50 Time: 1 hour

About Wine to Water's Water Filters

The water filter builds conducted by Wine to Water involve constructing and distributing portable filtration systems to provide clean and safe drinking water in communities lacking reliable access. Each water filter provides clean, safe water for a household of 10 people, supporting sustainable access to clean water sources and promoting long-term health and well-being for up to 10 years.

Wine to Water Considerations

- The Wine to Water Filter Kits contain everything you need to assemble your water filters.
- Orders need to be made through Wine to Water, so please email <u>kwilliams@winetowater.org</u>.
- Supplies are shipped to your location within 10-15 business days.
- All kits are mailed back to Wine to Water for their distribution.

IMPORTANT: If you're not among the first 10 to register but still want to host a Wine to Water Filter Kit Build, you can order kits directly from their website.



Plan: Water Filter Kit Build

Step-by-step directions to plan your next event.

1 Recruit	Select 2-3 employees or volunteers to form a Planning Committee.
2 Start Order Process	Contact Wine to Water to start the order process. Mention the number of volunteers and consult with them about the set-up for the event based on time and volunteers (i.e., how many kits should be ordered). Kits take 10-15 days to arrive.
3 Submit Your Grant	After reaching out to Wine to Water, the next step is to <u>submit your grant</u> (event) proposal. This allows Xylem Watermark to review and proceed with the sponsorship process.
4 Grant Approval	Xylem Watermark will inform both you and Wine to Water the grant has been approved.
5 Prepare For Event	Wine to Water will offer guidance and checklists to help ensure your event's success.
6 Publicity Release Form	Ensure that all attendees in photos sign the form provided (page <u>16</u>) before sharing photos on external channels. Hashtags suggested #MonthofAction #MakeyourWatermark #XylemWatermark

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Community Grants

Xylem Watermark offers up to \$10,000 in critical funds for employees and external business partners to support and collaborate on community centered development projects and events.

Through the Xylem Watermark Community Grants program, **any Xylem employee, customer, supplier, and partner within the Xylem business network** can apply for a Watermark Community Grant on behalf of a nonprofit organization. The nonprofit organization will be the recipient of the grant funds.

Watermark Community Grant Funding Priorities

Xylem strives to maximize social impact within our communities and support a culture of service among our people. To do this, Xylem Watermark partners with nonprofit organizations that are aligned with our global footprint and have proven track records for making a difference in four areas of focus:

- Education
- Environment
- Water access and infrastructure
- Water-related disasters

Funding Levels

Funding requests should fall within the range that aligns with the criteria for one of more of the following categories:

- number of volunteers,
- total volunteer hours, or
- number of people impacted

Funding Range	Criteria
Under \$1,000	10+ volunteers, 20+ volunteer hours, or 50+ beneficiaries
\$1,000 - \$2,999	15+ volunteers, 30+ volunteer hours, or 100+ beneficiaries
\$3,000 - \$4,999	25+ volunteers, 50+ volunteer hours, or 200+ beneficiaries
Funding Range	Criteria
\$5,000 - \$6,999	35+ volunteers, 70+ volunteer hours, or 300+ beneficiaries
	Conditionarios
\$7,000 - \$8,999	45+ volunteers, 90+ volunteer hours, or 400+ beneficiaries
